Elections were held and unanimous vote approved the reinstatement of Wayne Hertel for another term, and new board member, Jeff Robertson, was elected. Jeff has grown up at Deer Lake and has been a constant volunteer for many DLA projects, including yearly lake treatments. He is now our vice president.

A discussion of purchasing a DR trimmer for \$1300 to use for lake shore clean up ended in a vote to approve it. It will only be used for common grounds around the lake.

It was also approved for the board to spend up to \$4500 as needed to hire supplemental help to maintain the grounds. This program will be evaluated at the Fall Meeting to determine if it warrants continuation next year.

Fish and chemicals to treat the lake have been ordered.
