## Spring & Special Meeting Report

March 26, 2019 Spring meeting voted in 3 new board members; Sara Money, Robert Starkey, & Deborah Pohl. Jeff Robertson & Glen Flanders remain on the board. Those attending approved a motion to hire Aquatic Consultants to do an assessment of the lake.

May 26, 2019 Special Meeting was held at Sara's cabin with 41 attending. After hearing Aquatic Consultants recommendations for treating the lake it was voted to evaluate the effectiveness of it for next year and pay them from current funds. We encourage members who wish to contribute to this by sending checks to Deer Lake Assoc., memo: "Lake Maintenance".

## Important Deer Lake Updates

At least once a month since May, volunteers have met and removed 8 dead trees, mowed grass, pulled weeds, repaired the fence, removed debris from the lake, built and installed the 2nd floating dock, and completed trench work on the ditch that has a culvert. Volunteers are also removing weeds from the lake but it's a slow process. Aquatic Consultants have treated it several times and identified an emergent plant, knotweed, which is rare in NM. They believe it took hold last year when the lake level was so low. The water is much clearer and efforts on the upper lake will be treated in future visits.

Several members have sent in donations for lake maintenance totaling \$1700. so far. Thank You! It takes a village and all efforts are appreciated!

In August Jemez Mountain Electric Co-Op will cut trees along Pipeline Rd. in 6-8 ft. lengths. Get a permit from the Forest Service if you want any of these trees. They will then be trimming trees in Deer Lake close to power lines.
